On 1 March, **Katarzyna Stokłosa** and Gerhard Besier (Sigmund Neumann Institute) presented their publication *Neighbourhood Perceptions of the Ukraine Crisis. From the Soviet Union into Eurasia?* (Routledge Publishing, 2017), in a book launch presentation with reception at the University of Southern Denmark (SDU) in Sønderborg. After welcoming speeches by Steen Bo Frandsen, Monika Eigmüller (European University Flensburg) and Christian Elmelund-Præstekær, the book was reviewed by Barbara Törnquist-Plewa (Lund University).
